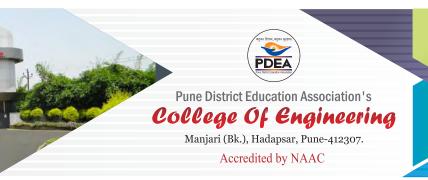
Apart from the regular academic inputs, students are given the co-curricular and extra-curricular activities opportunities coupled with soft skills training to ensure their wholesome development.

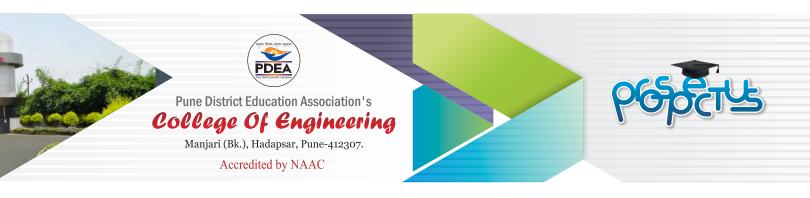

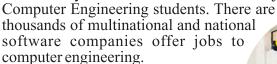

First year engineering department has been organized Exhibition on projects under the subject project based learning. Project based learning motivate students to learn by working in group courteously to solve a problem.

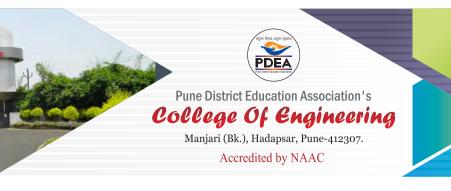

Say No To RAGGING

A) What Constitutes Ragging?

As per the AICTE/UGC/DCI Regulations & the Directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India "Ragging" constitutes one or any of the following Acts with or without any intention by any student or griup of students;

- 1. Any act of indiscipline, teasing or handling with rudeness.
- 2. Any act that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity.
- 3. Any activity which is likely to cause annoyance, hardships, physical or psychological harm or creates fear.
- 4. Any act of financoal extortion or forceful expenditure.
- 5. Any act of physical abuse causing assault, harm or danger to health or life.
- 6. Any act of abuse by spoken words, e-mail, sms, mms, or public Insult etc.
- 7. Any act of lnjury to the fundamental right to human dignity.
- 8. Any act of wrongful confinement, use of criminal force trespass or Intimidation.
- 9. Any unlawful assembly or abatement or conspiracy to "Ragging".

B) Punishment to those found guilty:

Any student or group of students found guilty of "Ragging" in the campus or hostels or college buses or even outside the campus shall be liable for one or more of the following punishment;

- 1. Suspension from attending classes & academic privileges.
- 2. Suspension or expulsion from hostels/college bus.
- Debarring from appearing in any session test/ university examination.
- 4. F.I.R. against the concerned student or group of students.
- 5. Withdrawing scholarshop and other benefits.
- 6. Fine up to Rs. 25,000 /- to the concerned student or group of students.
- Rustication from the Institution for a period of one to four semesters.
- 8. Expulsion from the Institution and also debarrong from admission to any other Institution through university.
- 9. Entry in the character / transfer certificates regarding the punishment given for any act of "Ragging".

Discipline & Attendance

We do spare the rod and do not spoil the students:

- 1. The students are advised to refer regularly to all notices displayed at various places on the notice board. Ignorance of the same shall not entertained as an excuse.
- 2. A students must always possess his/ her I card which must be produced on the demand by the college authorities.
- 3. The students shall attend lectures, practical's, tutorials, unit tests and examinations and shall keep their guardians in touch with the progress in their studies.
- 4. The students should note that they will not be permitted to appear for the university examinations if they fail to satisfy the college authorities on any of the following grounds;
- a. At least 75% attendance at lectuers/practicals.
- b. At least 75% at NCC parades / NSS work as prescribed.
- Attendance and performance at the college examinations/ tutorials.
- d. Good behavior and observance of discipline in the college premises.
- e. Obedience of the instructions of teachers/ staff and the other college authorities.
- f. Payment of college fees as instructed.
- Students should note that smoking, tobacco chewing, spitting etc. and use of mobile is strictly prohibited in the college campus.
- 6. Students must deactivate mobile of cell phones in the classrooms or laboratories or during academic activities.

Rules of Discipline

- 1. Students must observe strict discipline in the college premises/campus and should not disturb the college / teaching & administration in any manner what so ever. I have no objection incase of change of place & name of instructional, administrative and all over college related activities decided by college management in future.
- 2. Students should take proper care of the college property and help in keeping the premises clean, neat and tidy. Any damage, what so ever done will be treated as a serious breach of discipline and the cost of the damage(s) will be recovered from students.
- 3. No society or association shall be formed by the students in the college and no person should be invited to attend and address any meeting without prior permission of the principal.
- 4. Students should be regular and punctual in attending their lectures, practicals, tutorials and tests. students should refrain from remaining absent, however if a student ensures to remain absent for any genuine reason(s) prior permission of the Principal/HOD should be taken.
- 5. Students should not loiter about and sit bear class rooms, laboratories, in verandahs, stair case, cycle stand and play ground, going on. They should either go to the library or leave the college premises, in case there are no lectures or practicals.
- 6. Annual social gathering and any similar programmes / functions which are likely to disrupt the academic atmosphere on the colleges campus shall not be permitted.
- 7. Any one found indulging in any ragging within or outside the college shall be instantly expelled from the college.
- 8. Student must attend college in prescribed uniform, identity card.
