7.1.7 Initiatives taken by the institution to make the campus eco-friendly (at least five)

The following Seven initiatives have been taken by our institute:

A. Energy conservation: Program of electricity awareness at the Institute level to spread awareness about efficient use of electricity. Energy audit of college as well as campus has been done. While designing the buildings, the care has been taken to fetch maximum benefit from natural resources, like wind, sunlight to reduce consumption of electricity. The use of transparent glass window provides maximum sunlight to classrooms and Laboratories. Energy conservation display boards have been placed in each &every classroom &labs. Power factor is maintained close to unity. We have Centralized UPS systems for computers .Generator is placed away from classroom, to minimize noise pollution.

B. Use of Renewable Energy:

- Solar panels have been installed on the rooftop of Girls Hostel as well as Boys Hostel.
- Solar mobile chargers are also available in campus to charge the mobile phones.
- Wind mill model promotes use of alternative Energy sources in a campus.
- **C. Rain Water Harvesting:** For improvement of ground water level, Institute has Rain Water Harvesting in the campus.
- **D. Efforts for Carbon Neutrality:** Sufficient plantation on the campus has helped to increase green cover and keep the campus pollution free. Organic waste, generated from garden, is converted into compost instead of burning. Compost, so produced, is used as a fertilizer for the campus garden, thereby increasing reutilization. Waste paper generated is sold to vendor for recycling. Paper usage is minimized by printing on both sides of papers. Inter department correspondence is made through e-mails. In our college campus, plastic bags are not entertained.

PUC Testing: The PUC testing centre for vehicles at Mechanical Engineering Department is started in 2013-14 and it is approved by RTO Pune. A compulsory insurance coverage is mandated by the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988; the PUC Certification, also compulsory, is mandated by the Central Motor Vehicle Rule, 1989.

- **E. Tree Plantation:** Major area of campus is covered with plants & lawns. Various types of plants include medical plants like, bottle palm, Hibiscus Rosa sinesis, Vitexnegundo, etc. The flowers and leaves of these plants are combined to make in-house bouquets for felicitation of Guest who visits the Institute. College runs a Nursery which contains numerous eco-friendly plants. These plants are used by college as well as other people also.
- **F. Irrigation System**: As college has most of area covered by greenery, irrigation to all this plants as well as Lawn is done by more number of sprinklers. Due to this large amount of water saving is done..
- **G. Temperature/ Humidity Indicator**: This system is available with college for indicating temperature and humidity in environment to aware global warming.

National Service Scheme (NSS): Through NSS, the students acquire moral and ethical values of different programs.


BEST PRACTICE NO.1

Title of the Practice: "Teacher Guardian scheme (TGS)"

The Teacher Guardian scheme (TGS) is for continuous academic monitoring of students which is accompanied by "Student Training Program" for technical as well as soft skill enhancement of students for improved employability.

Goal:

- 1. In this scheme there is continuous monitoring of academic performance of students including their attendances and performance in internal exams as well as providing a support system to guide and motivate the students.
- 2. This scheme is used to enhance the technical and soft skills of the students to improve their employability.



Context: Teacher Guardian is like mentor to his students and he/she knows and understands his students personally. Each student has his own strengths and weaknesses. In each class, weaker sections are identified by the TG and reported to the other faculties teaching to that class and subsequently

more efforts are taken to educate and improve these section. Parents are regularly updated about the performance of their ward by his TG and thus they are also involved in this process. Teacher Guardian listens to the problems faced by the students like poor academic performance, problems related to infrastructural facilities, and even personal. The Teacher Guardian acknowledges and addresses these problems and also acts as a mentor to motivate and guide the students. Knowing the student personally and communicating with him/her like a guardian develops a personal connect between the TG and student which is the prime goal of this program.

The practice: The institute has a "Teacher Guardian Scheme" Program for all the students i.e. First, Second, Third and Final Year. Under this program, one faculty is appointed for every 20-25 students as their Teacher Guardian. The role of the appointed faculty is to continuously monitor the academic performance such as daily attendance of the these 20-25 students in lectures and practical, reporting the absentees of the students to their parents on a daily basis telephonically, monitoring their performance in internal examinations and conducting meetings with them regularly to discuss and address their academic as well personal problems of the these 25 students. This in turn develops a sense of confidence, support and security in the students and they are in a better position to face the academic challenges. Effective communication with the students helps their respective TGS to understand their strengths and weaknesses. Hence they can mentor them in the right direction. In some cases, counseling for time management, stress management etc. is also provided to the students by their Teacher Guardians. The details of the above work are maintained in a workbook by the respective Teacher Guardian.

Evidence of Success: The "Teacher Guardian scheme" has proved to be extremely successful in improving the overall attendance of the students. Many of the problems faced by the students have come up in the TG meetings and they have been addressed by the faculty members and management. E.g. Problems like need of water cooler in electronics department, need of fans etc. came up in the TG meetings and subsequently, these facilities were provided to the students. "Student Training scheme" has created an immense impact on the student performance in employer's satisfaction. Students are performing better in Group discussions, Personal interviews etc. and it is evident from the increased number of placements.

Problems Faced and Resources required:-Making the students realize the importance of "Student Training Program" in context of employability to increase their active participation. Our College provides soft skill training to the faculties from outside experts to conduct "Student Training Program".

BEST PRACTICE NO.2

Title of the Practice: "National Service Scheme (NSS)"

The institute's "National Service Scheme (NSS)" team regularly visits surrounding areas and villages where people are provided awareness on various social, moral, ethical principles and ways of life. Activities are conducted under NSS, so that the students acquire moral and ethical values in them.

Goals:

- 1. Understand the community in which student works.
- 2. Understand themselves in relation to their community.
- 3. Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem solving process.
- 4. Develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility.
- 5. Utilize their knowledge in finding practical solutions to individual and community problems.
- 6. Develop competence required for group living and sharing of responsibilities.
- 7. Gain skills in mobilizing community participation.
- 8. Acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitude.
- 9. Develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters
- 10. Practice national integration and social harmony.

Context: The National Service Scheme was started by Government of India, Ministry of Education and Culture, Govt. of India, in Collaboration with State Government in the year 1969 in 37 selected Universities. Savitribai Phule Pune University has been participating in the scheme right from its inception. NSS is an activity that is conducted by many colleges. The social cause are carried out through NSS club of our college. The unit is started with an objective to cultivate an attitude of social service in the minds of students and to make them responsible citizens. The Practice: The students are first made aware of NSS activity at the first year (FE) through introductory sessions. Students are selected for NSS unit on Interview basis. At the time of interview various qualities of students are checked such as social awareness, ready to work in rural area etc. Selected students forms NSS unit. The College has a NSS unit of 100 students. There is a staff in-charge who is assisted by a co-staff in-charges. Various socially relevant activities are being carried out by NSS students like tree plantation, Swachhata Abhiyan camps, social awareness camps, blood donation camps, medical checkup camps. NSS-unit has adopted Padvi, a village in the Tehsil Daund, since 2013-14. 7-days residential camp is arranged in this village every year in which almost 50 students (both boys and girls) participate. This has helped in building a rapport with the villagers and understanding their problems.

Evidence of Success:

- NSS organizes outreach programmed to enable the students to respond to the larger issues of society by visiting orphanages and old age homes. NSS unit donated Water Filter To Jeevan Wardhini Niwasi Matimand Vidyalay, Dive by their own contribution.
- Staff and students are actively involved in community activities such as Blood Donation, Tree Plantation, Clean And Green, Tobacco Free and 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan'.
- Every year near about 40 bottles of blood collected in Blood Donation Camps organized by NSS.

Problems Encountered and Resources Required:

Financial and human resources constraints have restricted our activity to areas

in and around Padvi. Transport facility between Padvi and college was major problem. In this regard Mr. Rajendra Shitole, Sarpanch of Padvi, provided us Transport Facility, by availing his Vehicle. Toilet facility

for NSS Volunteers was not available. This was solved by availing Mobile Toilet Van, by Sarpanch
